# Sunday, 25.8.: Sparkasse Day from 13:00 until 17:00 Free entry for children under 12: Family Sunday and Treasure Hunt for Children

The Ostsächsische Sparkasse Dresden and the OSTRALE Biennale invite you to a big family day at the art exhibition next Sunday (25.8.). In the historical building and the outdoor area of the former tobacco factory f6 (Schandauer Str. 68) there will be a colourful programme for the whole family. For example, the children can access the exhibition with a treasure hunt map and win small prizes. "It is close to our hearts to give children and their families a playful and creative approach to art," says Andreas Rieger, spokesman for the bank. Children up to the age of 12 have free admission! Visitors who pay with their SparkassenCard (debit card) receive a reduction of one euro off the admission price.

## Musical event

From 14:00 Dresden musician Jan Heinke will play a "sonic skylines timescapes live soundtrack" with his project "Chrononaut", in the Event Room (2nd floor). With his cello made of steel, sounding fossils from ethnological collections and found objects from the surrounding area, situation-related sound collages are created.

The OSTRALE Biennale has an excellent international network and is currently the third-largest temporary exhibition of contemporary art in Germany with over 300 works of art by around 180 artists from over 34 nations. It is not a sales exhibition per se, which gives it the freedom to discuss socially relevant topics away from market developments. The guiding principles of the OSTRALE, such as peaceful coexistence, acceptance of the stranger/unknown, respectful interaction, religious diversity and internationality are reflected in the exhibitions. The team of the OSTRALE Centre for Contemporary Arts has already organizedseveral large-scale events contributing to the contemporary artprogrammesof European Capitals of Culture, such as 2010 in Pécs, 2016 in W roclaw and 2018 in Valletta/Malta. In the European Capital of Culture 2020 Rijeka/Croatia, the OSTRALE will also contribute by shaping parts of the programme.
