OSTRALE Biennale opens the second exhibition in Valletta on June 1<sup>st</sup>

# Saxon exhibition of international contemporary arts in European's Capital of Culture Valletta

Dresden / Valletta. At European Capital of Culture Valletta's invitation, the team of OSTRALE Biennale for contemporary arts arranges already the second exhibition in Malta. The exhibition's opening takes place in "Spazju Kreattiv", in St. James Cavalier, Valletta on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Until July 29<sup>th</sup> numerous Saxon as well as international artists, which have been presented in the OSTRALE in the preceding years, are displayed. Thereby the OSTRALE is able to contribute to the international artistic discourse with contemporary positions from Saxony and Europe for the third time already. Previously this succeeded in the former European Capitals of Culture Pécs (Hungary, 2010) and Wroclaw (Poland, 2016) with broad presentations of contemporary art. OSTRALE's rearrangement to a biennial-rhythm in 2017 because of scarce resources had the intention to arrange not only the events in Dresden but also the international cooperations with a higher quality. In the past years the OSTRALE has realized fourteen projects abroad in nine countries in total.

With our partnership we want to expand the common strengths of a broad creative expertise and the international dimensions whilst presenting projects of high artistic excellence, which inspire people who are interested in art as well as those who are not. Thereby we want to build the base for the expansion of our partnership and the mutual cooperation for the next years."

Here in Malta we use the good interconnectedness of OSTRALE and extend it at the same time. The 2<sup>nd</sup> OSTRALE Biennale (12<sup>th</sup> OSTRALE) will take place from June 28<sup>th</sup> until September 29<sup>th</sup> 2019. The curators already have held a meeting and selected artworks with under the guiding principle "-ism", the location is not defined yet.
